# KLYRP Project Activities

- 113 young people registered to the project
  - 36 engaged with a work inspired activity, 28 of these have been referred to the Digital Youth Hub
  - 6 assessed as job ready, 5 of these have successfully secured employment
  - Existing procurement framework now up and running and reopening of framework planned in January
  - Courses planned
    - Dec 22 - Leadership in Management with Turning Factor
    - Jan 23 - Cyber Security – Opportunity Group, Customer Service & Retail – Pilot IMS, Confidence Building – The Workshop, CSCS Card – HSS, Wellbeing in Nature – Green Light Trust
  - Rebrand with local designer and CWA underway

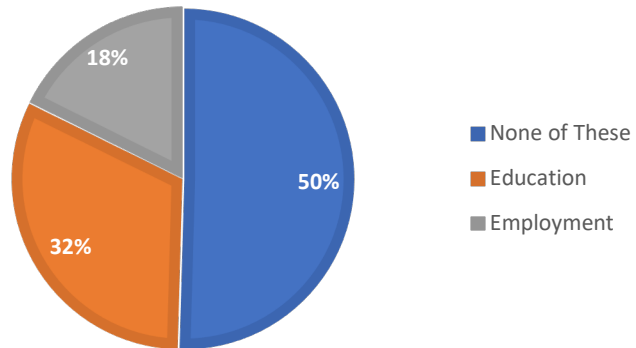
- Meetings taken place with CWA

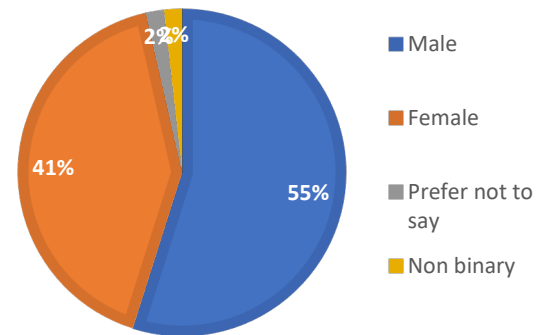

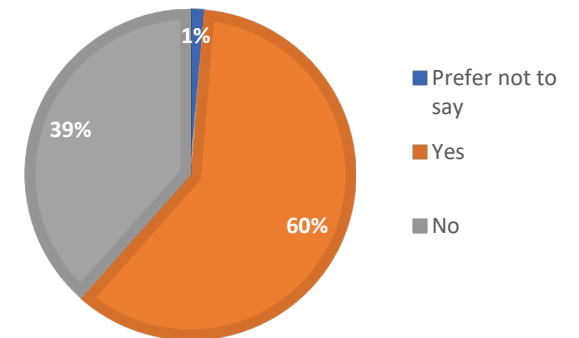
### EDUCATION AND EMPLOYMENT STATUS OF PARTICIPANTS



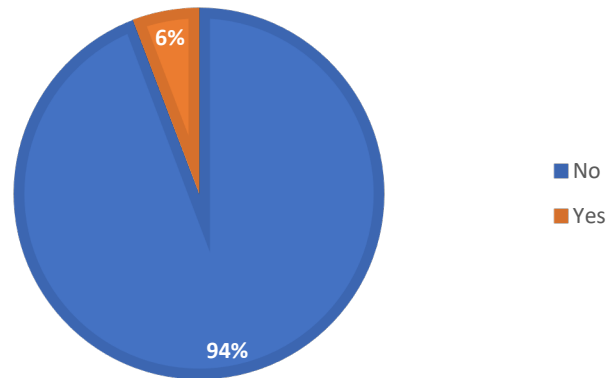
### GENDER IDENTITY



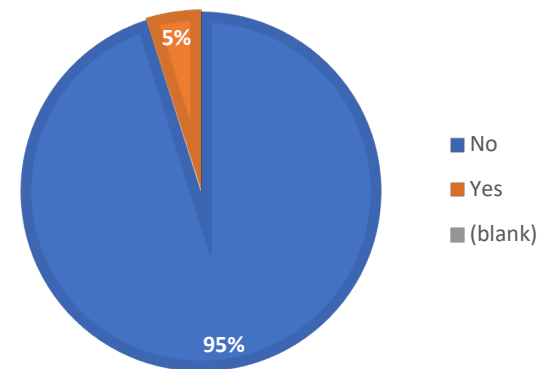
### PARTICIPANTS WITH A DISABILITY



### PARTICIPANTS WITH UNSPENT CRIMINAL CONVICTION

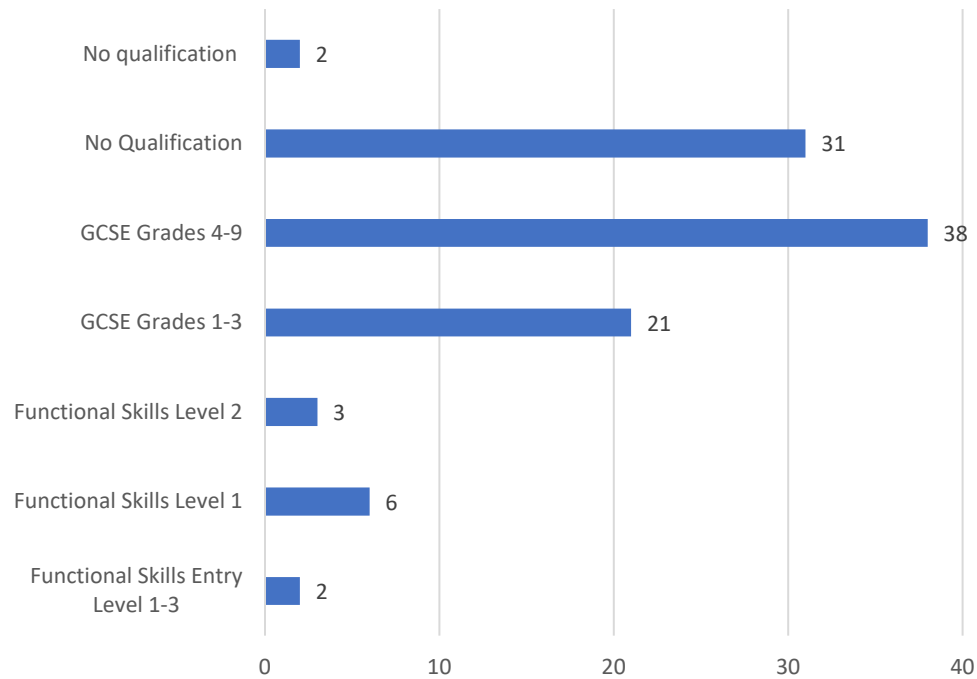


### PARTICIPANTS WHO ARE IN CARE/CARE LEAVERS

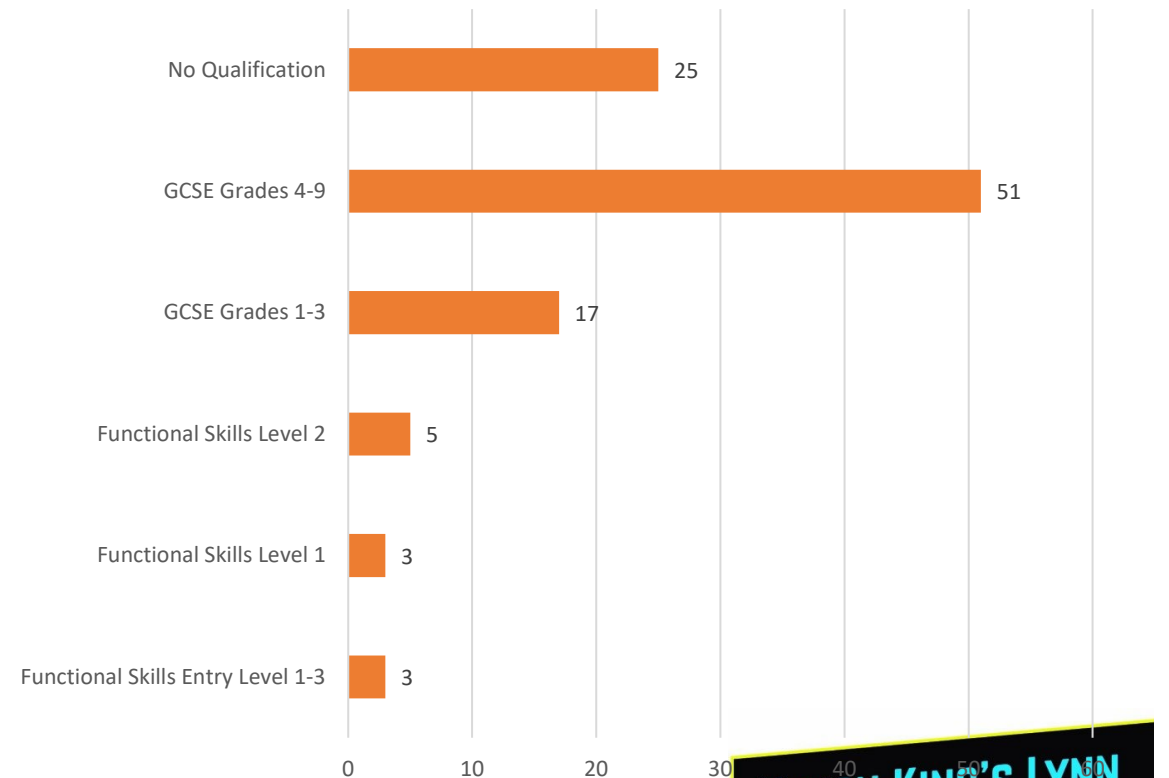

# Participant Case Study

- Y was referred via DWP
  - Looking for construction work having gained a Level 1 qualification at college
  - Father had just passed away and was left with nothing
  - Sofa surfing while waiting for council to house him
  - When contacted by DYH, he was walking the streets with no where to go
  - Ready to start work straightaway, even had work boots ready!
  - Referred to an employment agency who were looking for construction workers
  - Started work immediately the next day
- 
- For this young person finding work was the priority to secure accommodation
  - Intent to follow up in 3 months for further support

# Future Activities

- Continued focus on registration of young people to the project
- Rebrand in January
- Marketing campaign to engage employers
- Continue working with CWA – CSCS card training & commercial short courses
- Ongoing work with schools in collaboration with BCKLWN, Careers Hubs etc including school visits including Enterprise Challenge at Easter
- Further working with DWP including development of SWAPs
- Reopening of procurement framework for providers
- Developing new courses with existing framework
- Promotional activities to reach employed cohort including working with BCKLWN to share information with local employers
