## **Project Definition**

**Project Stage:** RIBA stage 5 – manufacturing and construction.

**Objectives:** Improve public realm in the town centre to improve the pedestrian experience, removing clutter, creating consistent public realm experience

**Scope:** Rail to River route works include providing interventions such as pop-up facilities, art trail, fingerpost wayfinding, lighting, seating and planting.

## 1. Overall Status (high-level summary)

Overall Status currently GREEN.

- Operators began selling from the Pop Ups end of March.
- Artwork, seating and wayfinding digital sign installed.
- 14 trees and bespoke planters installed on Purfleet Street, New Conduit Street and Broad Street.
- The Purfleet Street Arch is now the only outstanding item. Following the cancellation of the works order with Fransham Forge, a new artist will be sought via an updated Request for Quotation.
- A fire broke out in an adjacent building on Purfleet Street but did not cause any damage to the pop ups, trees or public realm but will have an effect on installation of arch and proposed seating area.

- Pop Ups inspected following fire on Purfleet Street, found safe to operate.
- Trees in immediate danger from Purfleet Street fire and building stabilisation works moved to temporary location.
- Local companies- The Pizza Slice Guy and Tiny Teeth's Burgers & Bites operating from the Pop Ups.





Timelines currently RAG rated AMBER. The proposed Arch at Purfleet Street is delayed. Firstly, due to non-delivery by supplier, licence issues with Boots and now uncertainty following the fire damage to Cashino. The building is covered in structural scaffold and would not currently be suitable to attach the arch.

All other items have been installed/completed. The delay with the arch does not affect any funding timescales.
